**G**eorgia American String Teachers Association Summer Orchestra Camp at the Calvin Center in Hampton, Georgia is a comprehensive orchestra curriculum for students in grades 4-8. GA ASTA developed this camp to encourage young string players as they discover the fun and rewards of making music together. The daily schedule is as follows:

The evening schedule changes each night and includes recitals, movies, and lots of other fun events! Registration begins at 2PM on the first day of camp and the final concert is in the afternoon or evening of the final day, depending on which session you sign up for. A full schedule for your session will be included in your camp packet 2 weeks before camp starts!

**C**amp Calvin is a beautiful wooded facility just south of Jonesboro about half an hour drive from downtown Atlanta. The main Conference Lodge is where most rehearsals and concerts take place. The Conference Lodge houses two students to a room or up to six per room fit in the nearby Geneva Lodge with all the modern conveniences. All meals are served cafeteria style just a short walk from the Conference Lodge and include a full salad bar and lots of healthy options at every meal.

**R**ecreational activities are a priority! Students will enjoy lifeguard supervised pool time, a camp fire, hay-ride, ice cream social, movies, and basketball. The middle school session also includes canoeing, a talent show, and a dance. Using the camp website parents will be able to attend a ‘*virtual camp*,’ as we upload pictures and videos of events as they happen!

**W**ith an anticipated enrollment of between 30 and 50 students per session, our teacher to student ratio is about 1 to 6. Students will work closely with these certified professional teachers every day in instrument specific sectional rehearsals, small group chamber ensembles, and large group orchestra rehearsals as they prepare for their final concert!

**T**he staff is composed of well known ASTA string teachers from throughout the state of Georgia. Students will be carefully supervised for their entire camping experience. Tim and Tricia Anderson serve as Camp Directors. Although individual members of the faculty may be different from year to year, our staff has included Sharon Anderson, Marilyn Seelman, Sarah Black, Evelyn Champion, Carl Rieke, Matt Thomas, Natascha Smith, Grace Song, James and Carolyn Landreau, Paula Swart, and many other outstanding teachers from the throughout the state.
